## Degree and Higher Diploma Programmes

### (Applicable to Secondary 7 students)

#### General Entrance Requirements

#### Degree Programmes

- Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (HKALE)  
Grade E or above in the following subjects:
  - AS-Level subject: Chinese Language & Culture<sup>1</sup>; and
  - AS-Level subject: Use of English; and
  - One other A-Level subject or two other AS-Level subjectsAND  
Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE)
  - Five subjects at Grade E / Level 2 or above, including Chinese Language and English Language<sup>2</sup>;
- OR
- Equivalent

#### Remarks:

1. If applicants do not have the required HKALE Chinese Language & Culture qualification, the following language results will be considered in the application for Degree programmes:
  - Grade E or above in HKALE Chinese Literature; OR
  - Grade D or above in an HKCEE language subject other than Chinese Language and English Language.
2. Applicants who took HKCEE English Language in 2006 or before should have attained Grade E or above (Syllabus B) / Grade C or above (Syllabus A).
3. Some programmes may have other specific entrance requirements. Please refer to the below section of "Specific Entrance Requirements of Individual Programme".
4. The study duration of Degree programmes is normally 4 years.
5. Applicants may be required to attend an interview. Interviews are conducted in regard to the medium of instruction of the programme.
6. Offering of study place is subject to the applicants' academic qualifications, interview / test performance (if applicable) and availability of study places.

#### Higher Diploma Programmes

- Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination (HKALE)  
One HKALE A-Level subject / Two AS-Level subjects at Grade E or above  
AND  
Hong Kong Certificate of Education Examination (HKCEE)  
Five HKCEE subjects at Grade E / Level 2 or above, including Chinese Language and English Language<sup>1</sup>;
- OR
- Equivalent

#### Remarks:

1. Applicants who took HKCEE English Language in 2006 or before should have attained Grade E or above (Syllabus B) / Grade C or above (Syllabus A).
2. Successful completion of one Applied Learning (ApL) course recognised by the Education Bureau in or before 2010 is deemed comparable to one HKCEE subject pass.
3. Some programmes may have other specific entrance requirements. Please refer to the below section of "Specific Entrance Requirements of Individual Programme".
4. The study duration of Higher Diploma programmes are normally 2 years.
5. Some programmes may require applicants to attend an interview or a test.
6. Offering of study place is subject to the applicants' academic qualifications, interview / test performance (if applicable), and availability of study places.
