Course Features

Course Aims

This course is designed to arouse the interest of senior secondary students in early childhood education. Students are equipped with a basic understanding of the developmental characteristics of children aged 0-6, the skills in taking care of children and designing play activities for children as well as the core value and services of early childhood education in Hong Kong. Through experiential learning in authentic early childhood education settings, students are given opportunities to develop creativity, communication skills and team spirit, cultivate positive values and attitudes, and explore interests and potentials in early childhood education.

Learning Modules

1. Child Development (30 hours)

- Basic understanding of child development
- Factors affecting children's development
- Stages and characteristics of children's development
- Children with diverse learning needs

2. Introduction to Early Childhood Education (24 hours)

- Importance, nature and function of early childhood education and services
- Features of a quality early childhood curriculum
- Current issues of early childhood education in Hong Kong
- Community-based family services in Hong Kong

3. Health Care for Young Children (15 hours)

- Personal hygiene and nutrition
- Prevention of common communicable diseases and accidents

Diversified Learning and Teaching Activities

There will be lectures with demonstrations, role plays, group discussions, presentations, workshops, visits to early childhood settings and workplace experience, etc.

Professional Recognition

This course has been registered in the Qualifications Register as a certificate programme at Qualifications Framework (QF) Level 3. Students will also obtain a QF Level 3 certificate in addition to HKDSE qualification upon successful completion of the course.

4. Learning through Play (54 hours)

- Play and children's development
- Key elements of play
- Basic principles in planning and implementing play activities
- Elective topics (choose only one)
 - Creative arts
 - Storytelling and nursery rhymes
 - Physical activity and music

5. Experiential Learning Programme (30 hours)

- Identification of core values and missions of early childhood education and services
- Design features of early childhood institutions
- Interacting with children
- Designing, implementing and evaluating play activities

6. Life and Career Planning for Being an Early Childhood Educator (27 hours)

- Understanding of personal qualities
- Attributes of an early childhood educator
- Work ethics of an early childhood educator
- Career development in early childhood education
