1	Test on Film and Video Industry	Written test	Students are required to complete a written test on an overview of the film and video industry. Question types include multiple choice and short questions.	October Year 1	5%
2	Cinematography	Practical assessment	Students are required to design and produce a sequence of moving images to demonstrate their basic visual storytelling skills and understanding of basic cinematography including composition, depth of focus, exposure, white balance and shot size.	December Year 1	15%
3	Editing a Dialog Scene	Practical assessment	Students are required to produce a dialog scene with ready-made movie clips by utilising the non-linear video editing system to demonstrate their understanding on editing theory and audio design.	March Year 1	15%
4	Script Writing and Storyboarding	Written test	Students are required to write a script and draw a storyboard according to a given story in a designated format.	May Year 1	15%
5	Visual Storytelling	Production project	(a) Group work: Students working in groups develop ideas and a storyline on a selected theme, and perform shooting to create footage. (b) Individual work: Each student is required to edit the footage to produce an individual version of an Announcement of Public Interests.	September Year 2	15%
6	Integrated Project on Short Film Production	Production project / Written report	(a) Group work: Students working in groups initiate a production project and produce a fictional short film. (b) Individual work: Each student is required to (i) write own scripts and edit own version of short film with the one produced in group and (ii) submit the whole production report, including a reflection report.	October Year 2	25%
7	Integrated Test on Film and Video	Written test	Students are required to complete a written test on an overview of the film and television industry, film studies and film critiques. Question types include multiple choice, short and long questions.	December Year 2	10%
