Entry Requirements

Applicants shall have at least 2-3 years relevant working experience and attained one of the following:

- Five HKCEE subjects at Grade E/Level 2 or above, including English and Chinese Language, or equivalent; or
- Five HKDSE subjects at Level 2 or above, including English and Chinese Languages, or equivalent; or
- Foundation Diploma or Project Yi Jin awarded by a recognized institution or equivalent; or
- Foundation Diploma (Level 3) or Yi Jin Diploma awarded by a recognized institution or equivalent; or
- Holder of Diploma programme awarded by the Vocational Training Council (VTC) or equivalent, and a pass in the entrance assessments*; or
- Completion of other QF Level 3 programme that is deemed acceptable to the Discipline; and a pass in the entrance assessments*; or
- Relevant Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) qualification(s) at QF Level 3 or above and a pass in the entrance assessments*
 - * Entrance assessments include an English written test and an English oral interview
