I. JOB TITLE : FIRE SERVICES PORTABLE EQUIPMENT FITTER

II. JOB LEVEL : SKILLED WORKER

III. JOB : Installs, maintains, inspects and repairs portable fire Services equipment.

IV. TRADE SKILLS : Ability to:

- 1. Correctly use and maintain the tools and equipment of the trade including power tools and test equipment.
- 2. Correctly operate and handle various types of portable fire services equipment.
- 3. Inspect various types of fire services portable equipment in accordance with updated fire regulations and/or manufacturer's instructions.
- 4. Test and repair various types of fire services portable equipment in accordance with updated fire regulations and/or manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Recondition and refill various types of fire services portable equipment in accordance with updated fire regulations and/or manufacturer's instructions.
- 6. Correctly and properly dispose the waste chemicals and un-used extinguishing agents involved.
- 7. Correctly use and maintain the workshop equipment satisfying the registration requirements for Class 3 FSI Contractors under the 'Fire Services Ordinance Chapter 95'.
- 8. Correctly instruct, supervise and transfer skills to any apprentice and semi-skilled worker assigned to him to ensure safety and quality of work.

V. TRADE THEORY : Knowledge of:

1. Basic fire services technology.

- 2. Characteristics and working principles of fire extinguishing agents and its applications.
- 3. Function and working principles of various types of fire services portable equipment.
- 4. Types of fire prevention, monitoring and alarming, and fire fighting equipment and systems.
- 5. Correct disposal methods for the waste and unused chemicals.
- 6. Workshop Management for Class 3 FSI Contractors.
- 7. Industrial hazards, safety and health precautions, and environmental concerns.
- 8. Installation practice and regulations, and relevant codes of practice.
- 9. Relevant ordinances and regulations.

Relevant training with a pass in the Class 3 FSI Contractor Examination.
