Entrance Requirements

Three HKDSE subjects at Level 2 or above (if English Language is not one of these subjects, applicants are required to attain Level 1 in it); or Equivalent

Remarks :

1. Applicants possessing "Attained / Attained with Distinction" performance in an HKDSE Applied Learning (ApL) subject are deemed to have attained "Level 2 / Level 3" respectively in one HKDSE subject and a maximum of two ApL subjects can be counted for admission purpose.
2. "Grade D or E / Grade C or above" in HKDSE Elective Subject Category C – other language subjects will be regarded as having attained "Level 2 / Level 3" respectively in HKDSE and one category C subject can be counted for admission purpose.

Tuition Fee

The tuition fees for the 2012/13 academic year are currently under review. These will be determined taking into account inflation, curriculum structure and other relevant factors. Tuition fees are subject to annual review.

If you accept the offer of study place, you have to pay a registration fee of HK\$5,000 and complete the registration procedure before a stipulated deadline. Any fees paid are not refundable unless the course is cancelled. Tuition fee for the first semester is payable in late September 2012 and that for the second semester in November or December 2012 (tentative).

In addition to tuition fees, students will be required to pay other fees, such as caution money, students' union fees and English Module Benchmarking Fee.

Financial Assistance

Students with financial difficulties can apply for the VTC Fee Remission Scheme (FR), or Extended Non-means-tested Loan Scheme (ENLS) offered by Student Financial Assistance Agency (SFAA). Applicants of ENLS must have the right of abode in Hong Kong or have resided or have had his / her home in Hong Kong continuously for THREE complete years prior to the commencement of the course.
