Our MSc programme is designed for those wishing to move into project management, either in the technical or business field, or into a new field of expertise.

Participants on this course can have a wide range of educational or industrial backgrounds such as Business and Management, Information Technology, Engineering, Social Sciences, Design, Law, Language Studies, etc.

It is suitable for those with work experience as well as those with little or no background in business.

WHAT TO LEARN

This programme will provide students with the methodologies, tools, principles and philosophies of successful project management.

Students will be able to build up the concepts of strategic thinking and apply to the areas of project planning and control, financial and human behavioural operations as well as managing organizational change. With the fast changing global economy and technology, it is important to possess strategic thinking in industrial and organizational project management.

In Hong Kong, there is a great demand for professionals with qualifications to manage both small and large scale projects and programmes. The University of Warwick, in collaboration with the Vocational Training Council (VTC), offers the MSc in Programme and Project Management to meet the needs of the emerging market.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Bachelor degree with second class honours or equivalent
- IELTS 6.5 or TOEFL 600 (Paper-based) /
 250 (Computer-based) / 92 (Internet-based)*
- * The above English proficiency requirement applies to non-native English speakers only. Applicants with at least 2 years of study in English speaking countries, such as UK, USA and Australia, etc. may apply for exemption.

Note: Applicants with relevant post-qualification experience will be considered on individual merit.
