VTC Graduate Offer Scheme

Frequently Asked Questions

1	Q: How can I join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”? What necessary procedures should I take note of?
	<p>A: Applicants who are holding Diploma of Foundation Studies / Diploma of Vocational Education / Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate may join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” during 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m. on 3 July 2026 via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) to apply for admission to Full-time Higher Diploma programmes. You are required to submit “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” programme choices via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal”. Applicants will be notified of the offer results on the same day via the Portal / email. You may also join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” in person at the Campuses. You will only be given one study place through the Scheme. You are NOT allowed to change or cancel the offer given, or to apply for other programmes before the registration deadline.</p>
2	Q: Who can join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”?
	<p>A: Holders of Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education, Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate, (i) who have not been given an offer on or before 24 June, OR (ii) those with “Conditional Offer” not meeting the stipulated offer conditions on 3 July, OR (iii) have not accepted the offer given, OR (iv) fresh applicants may join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” to apply for Higher Diploma programmes. Applicants holding VTC internal results should check their finalised offer results via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) starting from 12:00 noon on 3 July.</p> <p>You will also be notified of the converted point scores based on VTC internal results on 3 July. The converted point scores are applicable only on the day of “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”. Individual programmes may have specific entrance requirements. Please refer to the Admission Homepage (https://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission) for details.</p> <p>Applicants who are currently studying Diploma of Vocational Education (Senior Secondary Curriculum) (DVE(SSC)), should check their finalised offer results via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) on 15 July or join the “Central Admission Scheme”.</p>

3	Q: If I am given a firm / conditional offer on or before 24 June, can I apply for another programme again through “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”?
	A: Yes. If you have not yet registered the “Firm Offer” given on or before 24 June OR do not accept the “Firm Offer” converted from “Conditional Offer” on 3 July, you may join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” and apply for another Higher Diploma programme. If you are offered a study place through the Scheme, any other study places offered before will become null and void. You are NOT allowed to change or cancel the offer given, or to apply for other programmes before the registration deadline.
4	Q: If I have not submitted any application for Full-time Higher Diploma programmes, am I still eligible to join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”?
	A: Yes, to join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”, you should first create a new account and submit an online application form via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk), then pay an application fee of HK\$300. Please be reminded to upload the application fee receipt to the Portal and it will be verified by VTC. You will then be eligible to join “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”. The application fee is non-refundable.
5	Q: If VTC Graduate did not possess HKDSE Mathematics / Mathematics Extended Part (Module 1 or Module 2) at Level 2 or above, is he/she eligible to apply for the programme entrance requirement requires HKDSE Mathematics / Mathematics Extended Part (Module 1 or Module 2) at Level 2 or above?
	A: Yes, if you are graduate of Diploma of Foundation Studies with successful completion of Foundation Mathematics III; OR Diploma of Vocational Education with successful completion of Mathematics 3G / 3E; OR Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate with IGCSE Mathematics Grade C.
6	Q: Do I have to pay an application fee to join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”?
	A: If you have already submitted an online application for “Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes (AY2026/27)” and have paid the application fee, you are not required to pay the application fee again for the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”.
7	Q: What types of programmes can I apply through the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”? How many programmes can I apply for?
	A: You may apply for Full-time Higher Diploma programmes through the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”. You can choose a maximum of 2 programme choices, and 1 campus preference for each programme choice. However, applicants will only be given one study place through the Scheme.

8	Q: I'm a VTC graduate and I also possessed other academic qualifications, should I provide these qualifications?
	A: If you also possess other academic qualifications, please fill in your qualification in the application form and upload them to “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) for perusal.
9	Q: What are the admission criteria of the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”?
	A: Offering of study place is subject to the applicants’ academic qualifications, work experience and/or prior qualification, interview performance (if applicable) and availability of study places. Please refer to the VTC Admission Homepage (https://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission) for the entrance requirements of individual programmes.
10	Q: I've submitted programme choice(s) in “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”, when will I have the offer results?
	A: You may check your latest offer status in “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). You will be also notified of the offer results via email. Please verify your email address is inputted in the Portal correctly.
11	Q: If I am not given an offer through “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”, can I apply for another programme again?
	A: Yes. You may join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) during 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m. on 3 July 2026 to submit programme choices for other Full-time Higher Diploma programmes. You may also join the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” in person at the Campuses.
12	Q: If I am given an offer through the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme”, how should I complete the registration procedures?
	A: If you are given an offer through the “VTC Graduate Offer Scheme” on 3 July, you should download “Payment Advice for New Student Registration” and “Notes on Acceptance of Offer and Registration” via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) and complete the following actions by 12:00 noon on 8 July (Wednesday): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Pay a registration fee of HK\$5,000; and ■ Upload the registration fee payment receipt or screen capture to “VTC S6 Admission Portal” / “VTC Articulation Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). Failure to pay the required fee and complete the registration procedures by the registration deadline will render the offer null and void.

13 Q: What should I do if I've forgotten my "Registered Email" / "Password" to login to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal"?

A: You may login to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal" by using your personal information.

14 Q: What should I do after paying registration fee?

A: After you have paid registration fee, you have to upload registration fee receipt / screen capture to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal" / "VTC Articulation Portal" (<https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk>) by the registration deadline. It will normally take 2 working days for campus to verify your payment. You will then receive a confirmation email. Please follow the instructions to submit new student registration information and upload student photo.

Students who will be under 18 years old before class commencement must obtain the written consent from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) by having them complete a separate Parents/Guardians Consent Form. This form will be collected by the New Student Registration System or Campus Secretariat. Without the required consent form, VTC may have difficulty in arranging some of the teaching and learning activities for a student minor, and therefore, his or her studies may be affected. Failure to complete and submit the Parents/Guardians Consent Form within a reasonable time will result in de-registration, and any fees paid will not be refunded.
