
Central Admission Scheme

Frequently Asked Questions

1	<p>Q: How can I join the “Central Admission Scheme”? What necessary procedures should I take note of?</p> <p>A: Starting from the date of HKDSE result announcement (i.e. 16 to 18 July 2025 (9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) and 19 to 21 July 2025 (9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon)), you may join the “Central Admission Scheme” via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) to apply for admission to Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes. You are required to submit “Central Admission Scheme” programme choice(s) via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). Applicants will be notified of the offer results on the same day of submission of application form via the Portal / email. You may also join the “Central Admission Scheme” in person at the Campuses. You will only be given one study place through the Scheme. You are NOT allowed to change or cancel the offer given, or to apply for other programmes before the registration deadline.</p>
2	<p>Q: Who can join the “Central Admission Scheme”?</p> <p>A: Applicants who (i) have not been given an offer on or before 16 July, OR (ii) those with “Conditional Offer” not meeting the stipulated offer conditions on 16 July, OR (iii) do not / have not accepted study place offered (iv) fresh applicants have not submitted any application may join the “Central Admission Scheme” and apply for Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes. Individual programmes may have specific entrance requirements. Please refer to the Admission Homepage (https://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission) for details.</p>
3	<p>Q: If I am given a firm / conditional offer on or before 16 July, can I apply for another programme again through “Central Admission Scheme”?</p> <p>A: If you have not registered the “Firm Offer” given on or before 16 July, you may join the “Central Admission Scheme” and apply for another programme. If you are offered a study place through the Scheme, any other study places offered before will become null and void. You are NOT allowed to change or cancel the offer given, or to apply for other programmes before the registration deadline.</p>
4	<p>Q: If I do not accept the converted “Firm Offer” by 4pm on 16 July, can I indicate accept the offered programme again?</p> <p>A: No. You may join the “Central Admission Scheme” via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) to apply again for admission to Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes which still have available study places from 16 to 21 July.</p>

5	Q: If I have not submitted any application for Full-time S6 programmes, am I still eligible to join the “Central Admission Scheme”?
	A: Yes. To join the “Central Admission Scheme”, you should first create a new account and submit an online application form via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk), then pay an application fee of HK\$300. Please be reminded to upload the application fee receipt to the Portal and it will be verified by VTC. You will then be eligible to join “Central Admission Scheme”. The application fee is non-refundable.
6	Q: Do I have to pay an application fee to join the “Central Admission Scheme”?
	A: If you have already submitted an online application for “Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes (AY2025/26)” and have paid the application fee, you are not required to pay the application fee again for the “Central Admission Scheme”.
7	Q: What types of programmes can I apply for through the “Central Admission Scheme”? How many programmes can I apply for?
	A: You may apply for Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programmes which still have available study places through the “Central Admission Scheme”. You can choose a maximum of 2 programmes and 1 campus preference for each programme choice. However, applicants will only be given one study place through the Scheme.
8	Q: Other than HKDSE results, I also possessed other academic qualifications, should I provide these qualifications?
	A: If you also possess other academic qualifications, please fill in your qualification in the application form and upload them to “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) for perusal.
9	Q: Can I use results of the same public examination in different years of award in the application for admission to the programmes?
	A: Yes. You can apply with results of the same public examination obtained in different years. The best grade of multiple attempts on a particular subject will be assessed for admission.
10	Q: What are the admission criteria of the “Central Admission Scheme”?
	A: Offering of study place is subject to the applicants’ academic qualifications, work experience and/or prior qualification, interview performance (if applicable), other learning experience and achievements, and availability of study places.
11	Q: I’ve submitted programme choice(s) in “Central Admission Scheme”, when will I have the offer results?
	A: You may check your latest offer status in “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). You will be also notified of the offer results via email. Please login to the “VTC S6 Admission Portal” to verify your email address is correct.

12	Q: If I am given an offer through the “Central Admission Scheme”, how should I complete the registration procedures?
	<p>A: If you are given an offer, you should download the payment advice and registration documents, and complete the procedures <u>by 12:00 noon on 21 July (Monday)</u>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Pay a registration fee of HK\$5,000; <u>and</u> ■ Upload the registration fee payment receipt or screen capture to “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). <p>Failure to pay registration fee and upload registration fee payment receipt by registration deadline will render the offer null and void.</p>
13	Q: If I am not given an offer through “Central Admission Scheme”, can I apply for another programme again?
	<p>A: Yes. You may join the “Central Admission Scheme” via “VTC S6 Admission Portal” (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) during 16 to 21 July 2025 to apply again for other Full-time Degree, Higher Diploma, Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education and Diploma programme which still have available study places. You may also join the “Central Admission Scheme” in person at the Campuses.</p>
14	Q: Is there any programme I can apply for if my HKDSE result does not meet the minimum entrance requirements of the Higher Diploma programmes?
	<p>A: You may apply for Diploma of Foundation Studies, Diploma of Vocational Education or Diploma programmes through the “Central Admission Scheme” during 16 to 21 July. Please refer to the Admission Homepage (https://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission) for relevant programme information.</p>
15	Q: Can I apply for admission to THEi’s Degree programmes under Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions / Sectors (SSSDP) through the “Central Admission Scheme”?
	<p>A: No. You can only apply for admission to Self-financed THEi’s Degree programmes through the “Central Admission Scheme”.</p>

16	<p>Q: What should I do if I've forgotten my "Registered Email" / "Password" to login to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal"?</p>
	<p>A: You may login to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal" by using your personal information.</p> 
17	<p>Q: What should I do after paying the registration fee?</p> <p>A: After you have paid registration fee, you have to upload registration fee receipt / screen capture to the "VTC S6 Admission Portal" (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk) by the registration deadline. It will normally take 2 working days for campus to verify your payment. You will then receive a confirmation email. Please follow the instructions to submit new student registration information and upload student photo.</p>
18	<p>Q: What should I do to complete New Student Registration?</p> <p>A: You may login to the "New Student Registration System" via the "VTC S6 Admission Portal" (https://s6portal.vtc.edu.hk). Please contact the offering campus / institute for enquiry.</p>
