Course Features

Course Aims

This course aims to develop students' creativity and to equip them with the basic knowledge and skills required for interior design, enabling them to apply their learning to the creation of ideas and development of spatial design. Emphasis is also placed on enriching students' understanding of culture, aesthetics, technology, design and society.



Diversified Learning and Teaching Activities

Activities such as case studies, projects, artistic work appreciation, professional talks and sharing, visit to important city spaces and landmarks of significant values in Hong Kong, etc. will be arranged.

Simulated Learning Environment

Equipped with industry-standard facilities and equipment, e.g. Drawing Studio, Design Studio, Three-Dimensional Design Workshop, Photographic Studio, etc. for students to practise related knowledge and skills.

Professional Recognition

Students will obtain a Qualifications Framework (QF) Level 3 certificate in addition to HKDSE qualification upon successful completion of the course.

Learning Modules

1. Design Principles and Appreciation (30 hours)

- Interior design as a profession and design business in local and global context
- Aesthetics and appreciation of 3D forms and spaces
- Spatial design and end-users' needs
- Design process basics
- Work ethics

2. Visualisation and Presentation Techniques (30 hours)

- Drawing tools and media
- Basic perspectives
- Computer-aided design fundamentals
- Introduction to software and hardware for visual presentation
- Presentation of 3D space on 2D drawings
- Working models to express 3D form/space

3. Interior Design and Built Environment (30 hours)

- Interior design basics
- Different professions of spatial design
- Living spaces around us and characteristics of city spaces

- Green concept and sustainability of built environment
- Basic principles of common building structure in Hong Kong and concern of structural safety
- Field visits and sharing sessions with interior designers: appreciation of different types of city spaces in authentic context

4. Interior Product Design (30 hours)

- Categories of interior products
- Basic properties of different interior materials
- Green materials and technology
- Form and structure of furniture and lighting design
- Integration of interior space and interior products

5. Lifestyle Interior Design Project (60 hours)

- Appreciation of good interior design projects
- Ideal living space and interior product
- Lifestyle interior design project — "My Room" / "Our Space"
- Presentation of lifestyle interior design project
- Interior design exhibition

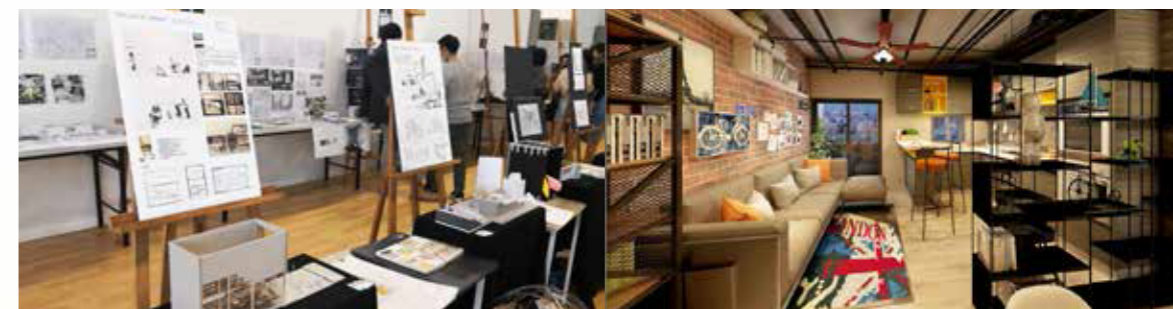
Further Studies
