| 2 | Practical Assessment on Front Office Services | Practical Assessment | Students are required to perform a practical task of 5 to 10 minutes in response to customers' requests relating to front office services. | December – February Year 1 | 15% |
| 3 | Practical Assessment on Housekeeping Services | Practical Assessment | Students are required to perform a practical task of 5 to 10 minutes in response to customers' requests relating to housekeeping services. | April – June Year 1 | 15% |
| 4 | Written Test on Front Office and Housekeeping Services | Written Test | Students are required to complete a written test on the front office and housekeeping services. Question types include multiple-choice questions and short questions. | April – June Year 1 | 15% |
| 5 | Integrated Assessment on Food and Beverage Services | Written Test and Practical Assessment | (a) Written test: Students are required to complete a written test on food and beverage services. Question types include multiple-choice questions and short questions. (b) Practical assessment: Students are required to perform a practical task of 5 to 10 minutes in response to customers' requests relating to food and beverage services. | September – November Year 2 | 20% |
| 6 | Project on Future Development of the Hotel Industry | Project Report and Oral Presentation | Students working in groups will complete a project which aims to analyse future development of the hotel industry and to make recommendations. Each group is required to submit a project report in 1,500 to 2,000 words and each member will give an oral presentation of about 5 minutes in class. | November – December Year 2 | 25% |
