At the invitation of the National Institute of Technology (NIT), a delegation led by Dr Michael Wang, Deputy Executive Director of VTC, Dr Daniel Yan, Academic Director of Engineering and Principal of Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (Tsing Yi) attended the commemorative events of the 60th Anniversary of the "KOSEN" system, a 5-year engineering education system in Japan. The NIT, comprising 56 colleges, provides unique and gainful higher education for young people aged 15 in Japan to groom them into engineering professionals. Over the years, VTC and NIT have been collaborating closely to organise various knowledge and skills exchange activities for staff and students of both sides. The visit this time further cemented the partnership. In addition to the Commemorative Ceremony, the VTC delegation also joined a symposium, an international university / college presidents' forum, and visited NIT (Tokyo College) to explore further collaboration opportunities on promoting VPET.
