陳司長亦與參加「灣區探索行」的VTC學生與深圳 職業技術大學學生交談,了解他們共同開展的 不同科研項目,以及就深化港深兩地職專教育合作 交流意見。

陳司長欣悉VPES自去年成立以來,運作暢順,積極 擔當職專教育交流平台的角色,推動VTC與內地 院校、企業和機構合作,通過課程交流、專題研習、 工作實習等活動,協助更多香港青年了解國家 發展,並讓內地青年認識香港職專教育和發展 出路,其中包括通過去年《施政報告》公布的職專 畢業生留港計劃,讓在VTC修讀指定全日制高級 文憑課程的內地青年畢業後可留港一年,尋找相關 專業的工作。

The Chief Secretary for Administration of the HKSAR Government, Mr Chan Kwok-ki, led a HKSAR delegation to visit the Vocational and Professional Education Services (Shenzhen) Company Limited (VPES), VTC's first Mainland operation centre, on 10 January. During the visit, Chief Secretary met with VTC Chairman, Mr Tony Tai, VPES Chairman and VTC Deputy Chairman, Dr Daniel Yip, as well as VTC Executive Director, Mr Donald Tong and VTC Deputy Executive Director, Ms Alaina Shum, to understand about VPES' operations and exchanged views.

Mr Chan spoke with VTC students participating in the GBA Explorer Trip and students from Shenzhen Polytechnic University. He also learned about the students' joint scientific research projects and exchanged views on strengthening Hong Kong-Shenzhen co-operation in vocational and professional education and training (VPET).

Mr Chan was pleased to learn that the VPES has been operating smoothly since its establishment last year. As a VPET exchange platform, it has promoted collaboration between the VTC and educational institutions, enterprises and organisations on the Mainland in areas such as programme exchanges, field studies and workplace attachments. It aims to help more young people from Hong Kong understand the country's development while also enabling Mainland youth to learn about the VPET scene and different articulation pathways in Hong Kong, including the option for Mainland youth graduating from VTC's designated full-time Higher Diploma programmes to stay in Hong Kong for one year to seek jobs relevant to their under the Vocational Professionals disciplines Admission Scheme (VPAS) announced in the Chief Executive's 2023 Policy Address.
