

# VTC Info Days for visitors to experience VPET’s interactive teaching and learning and explore multiple pathways



The Info Day features mutiple Admission Talks by VTC Education Advisors to share updates on VTC programmes, admission information and programme-related career prospects, helping students to plan their further studies and career pathways.

VTC's member institutions including Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi), the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (IVE), Hong Kong Design Institute (HKDI), Hong Kong Institute of Information Technology (HKIIT), Hotel Tourism Institute (HTI)/ Chinese Culinary Institute (CCI)/ International Culinary Institute (ICI) organised their Info Days last November. Students, parents and teachers had the opportunity to experience the VTC “think and do” teaching approach through campus tours, talks, taster activities and workshops, and learn more about the multiple pathways of vocational and professional education and training (VPET).

## Benefits from diversified and interactive activities

Taster activities and interactive workshops were offered at IVE, HKDI, HKIIT and HTI/CCI/ICI Info Days for visitors to experience the interactive, vibrant learning atmosphere at the VTC. Visitors were also given the chance to tour around various simulation and innovative training facilities, such as the Metaverse Innovation Centre, Wine and Beverage Laboratory, Dispensing Training and Pharmaceutical Care Resource Centre and Augmented Reality and Virtual Reality Lab, to understand how VTC students acquire industry-specific skills with the purpose-built facilities. Programme talks and industry sharing were also conducted for parents and students to get to know the programmes information and the latest industry trends. At THEi’s Info Day, a variety of activities including admission talks and booth activities offered by academic departments were featured to let visitors learn about THEi’s innovative degree programmes and campus life.

The VTC Info Days recorded over 20,000 visits. Guided tours, admission talks, and information corners were also arranged at the campuses for non-local visitors to learn about VPET study opportunities at VTC, paving the way for future professional development.
