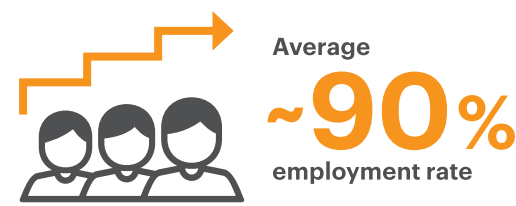

Our programmes combine theoretical knowledge with practical training, enabling students to gain valuable experiences through workplace attachment programmes or experiential learning.

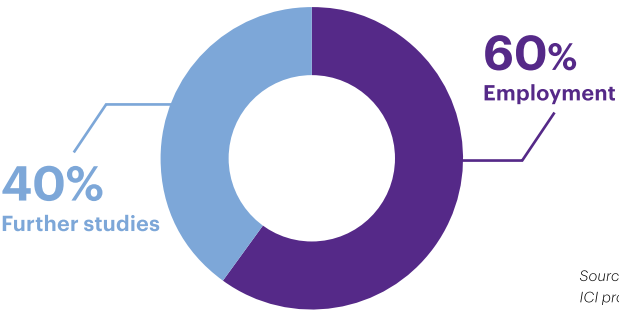

ARTICULATION AND EMPLOYMENT



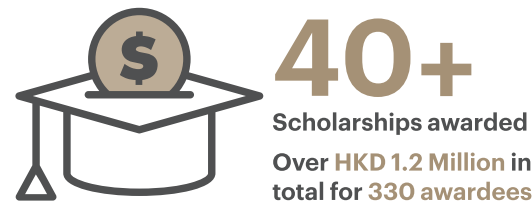

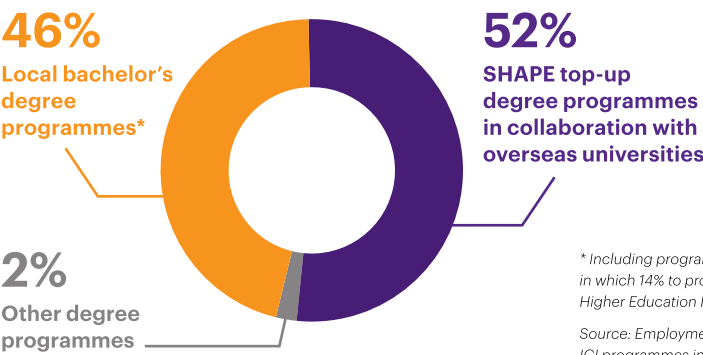

Notes

1. Higher Diploma (HD) graduates can apply for admission to top-up degree programmes offered by VTC in collaboration with overseas universities or degree programmes offered by local or overseas universities.
2. Technological and Higher Education Institute of Hong Kong (THEi) admits eligible Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education graduates or applicants with equivalent qualification to its Bachelor's Degree programmes; and students with HD or equivalent sub-degree qualifications in a relevant area of study may be admitted into Year 3 of the degree programme. Duration of study for full-time top-up degree programmes offered by THEi is usually two years. Please visit THEi website for details.
3. The duration of Bachelor's Degree programmes offered by our partner universities in collaboration with the School for Higher and Professional Education (SHAPE) are one year (Full-time) and 18-24 months (Part-time) respectively. Please visit SHAPE website for details.
* The application for registration of the courses in collaboration with UWE Bristol has been submitted to Non-local Courses Registry and is under process.
4. Students who have completed Secondary 6 (S6) are eligible for admission to the one-year Diploma of Foundation Studies (DFS) – Design and the Diploma of Vocational Education (DVE) programmes, namely Design and Print Media, Fashion, Interior and Exhibition Design, and Jewellery Design and Technology.
5. Holders of the Diploma of Foundation Studies (DFS) and Diploma of Vocational Education (DVE) award, upon successful completion of prescribed modules, are eligible to apply for HD programmes, as well as module exemption based on comparable formal academic achievements, subject to approval. Specific entrance requirements may apply to certain programmes.
6. Upon completion of the Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate (DVB) programme, students can progress to degree or higher diploma programmes in Hong Kong and abroad, subject to their internal and external academic results. Students shall pay attention to the specific entrance requirements of some degree / higher diploma programmes (if applicable).
7. Students who have completed Secondary 3 (S3) or above are eligible for admission to the three-year Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate (DVB) – Design and the Diploma of Vocational Education (DVE) programmes, namely Design and Print Media, Fashion, Hairdressing, Image Design, Interior and Exhibition Design, and Jewellery Design and Technology.

General Information

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who wish to apply for full-time post-secondary 6 programmes offered by HKDI in the Academic Year 2023/24 should meet the following general entrance requirements:

Higher Diploma Programmes

Five HKDSE subjects at Level 2 or above, including English Language and Chinese Language;
OR • VTC Foundation Diploma (Level 3) / Diploma of Foundation Studies; OR • VTC Diploma in Vocational Education / Diploma of Vocational Education / Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate*; OR • Yi Jin Diploma / Diploma Yi Jin; OR • Equivalent

** Upon Completion of the Diploma of Vocational Baccalaureate (DVB) programmes, students can progress to degree or higher diploma programmes in VTC, subject to their BTEC and IGCSE results. Students shall pay attention to the specific entrance requirements of some degree / higher diploma programmes (if applicable)*

Completion of Secondary 6 (under the New Senior Secondary Academic Structure); OR • Equivalent

Remarks:

1. The study duration of Higher Diploma programmes is normally 2 years.
2. The study duration of Diploma of Foundation Studies and Diploma of Vocational Education programmes is normally 1 year.
3. An "Attained", "Attained with Distinction (I)" and "Attained with Distinction (II)" in an HKDSE Applied Learning (ApL) subject (Category B subjects) are regarded as equivalent to an HKDSE subject at "Level 2", "Level 3" and "Level 4" respectively, and a maximum of two ApL subjects (excluding ApL(C)) can be counted for admission purpose.
4. A "Grade D or E" and a "Grade C or above" in an HKDSE Other Language subject (Category C subjects) are regarded as equivalent to an HKDSE subject at "Level 2" and "Level 3" respectively, and one Other Language subject can be counted for admission purpose.
5. Holders of Diploma in Vocational Education/Diploma of Vocational Education (DVE) (students admitted to DVE in AY2017/18 or before are required to complete prescribed further studies modules) and holders of Yi Jin Diploma/Diploma Yi Jin are considered having met the general entrance requirements of Higher Diploma programmes (not applicable to programmes with specific entrance requirements).
6. Individual programmes may have specific entrance requirements. Please refer to the Admissions Homepage (<http://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission>) for details.
7. Offering of study place is subject to the applicants' academic qualifications, interview / test performance (if applicable), other learning experience and achievements, and availability of study places.

TUITION FEE

- The tuition fees for the 2023/24 academic year are currently under review. These will be determined taking into account inflation, curriculum structure and other relevant factors. Tuition fees are subject to annual reviews.
- The tuition fees for the 2023/24 academic year will be announced on the Admissions Homepage (<http://www.vtc.edu.hk/admission>) at a later stage.
- The study duration of Higher Diploma programmes is normally 2 years. The tuition fee is payable in two instalments each year.
- The study duration of Diploma of Foundation Studies and Diploma of Vocational Education programmes is normally 1 year. The tuition fee is payable in two instalments.

1. In addition to tuition fees, students will be required to pay other fees, such as caution money and students' union annual fees. Students of Higher Diploma Programmes will be required to pay the study package fees for English modules and Chinese & Putonghua modules.
2. Some students may be required to study bridging modules or enhancement programmes to support their study; or to attend additional training, industrial attachments, public examinations for which separate fees will be charged.
3. Students of Diploma of Foundation Studies programmes may choose to take the optional module "Foundation Mathematics III" with a separate tuition fee.
4. The information listed above is only applicable to local students.
5. Tuition fees are subject to annual review.

Design Boulevard

CENTRE FOR INDEPENDENT LANGUAGE LEARNING (CILL)

A rich language learning environment is fostered for students to learn English and Putonghua in an inviting and relaxing atmosphere with the support of native English-speaking coordinators stationed in CILL.

DESIGN BOULEVARD

Stretching over 125 meters and conceived as a “breathing space” for the campus, this open area connects the four towers of HKDI, the auditorium and exhibition spaces, offering space for public events, student activities and the interaction of creative minds.



Exhibition Spaces

EXHIBITION SPACES

Open to the public to showcase the breadth of design generated in HKDI and beyond. HKDI Gallery, d-mart and Experience Centre provide a combined exhibition space of over 1,800 square metres. Exhibitions, trade and industry related events, and displays of student works are hosted in these three venues.



Learning Resources Centre (LRC)

LEARNING RESOURCES CENTRE (LRC)

A laboratory for inspired knowledge, LRC offers students all the information and data tools they need to transform lessons learnt into understanding and creative action.

MAKERSPACE

A collaborative space and digital output centre with emerging technologies including 3D printing and scanning, 12-colour large format printing, laser cutting service, UV printing service and photography kiosk.



MAKER COMMONS

With various workstations and different study facilities, Maker Commons provides an open and flexible home-based self-study area for students to work and study anytime.



STUDIO INFINITY

A multipurpose and comprehensive studio embedded with advanced facilities such as video wall, touch panel, wireless projection, high quality PTZ camera and flexible furniture.

VTC AUDITORIUM

The staging, acoustics and seating in the auditorium make it a world-class space for performances, conferences and fashion shows.



Knowledge Centres

Centre for Communication Design (CCD)

HKDI's Visual Communication and Culture Lab — CCD is dedicated to the advancement of knowledge in all areas of graphic communication and visual culture, including typography, information design, advertising, user experience design, illustration, brand communications, and printing and publishing. Consisting of the Hong Kong Graphic Archive, Rennie's Mill Press and a research and consultancy unit, it tightly integrates practice, research, teaching and outreach activities and acts as a knowledge exchange platform among staff, students and external organisations.



Knowledge Centres *(cont'd)*

Centre of Design Services and Solutions (CDSS)

HKDI's Retail Knowledge Lab — CDSS serves as a multi-disciplinary retail knowledge exchange hub for academics and retailers locally, regionally and internationally, with a vision to build business strategies and design solutions for future challenges

by synergising latest developments, innovative ideas and best practices.

Its services comprise the four areas of big data analytics, e-commerce, design incubation and technology-driven in-store experience, bringing design innovation, creative ideas and business solutions under one roof.



Centre of Innovative Material and Technology (CIMT)

HKDI's Material Lab – CIMT is a comprehensive material lab for all design disciplines. It aims to inspire the creativity of students and facilitate material innovation, multidisciplinary studies and collaborations. Housing

over 2,000 kinds of cross-disciplinary classical, sustainable and innovative materials sourced locally and globally, it offers students first-hand experience of a wide range of cutting-edge materials, unconventional multi-material applications, and innovative end-products from different design industries.



Knowledge Centres *(cont'd)*

Fashion Archive

HKDI's Fashion Resource Lab — Fashion Archive is a pioneering and interactive fashion resource lab in Hong Kong, connecting local and international fashion industry and design professionals, facilitating partnerships and alliances between academia and industry and providing space for theme-based fashion and culture exhibitions and workshops.

Housing over 2,000 fashion items sourced around the world, it provides wide-ranging real-life fashion resources contributing to teaching and learning and applied research. The access to iconoclastic fashion items through its physical and digital archiving system helps enhance visitors' understanding in fashion design, culture and history.



HKDI Design for Social Innovation and Sustainability (DESIS) Lab

HKDI's Social Design Research Lab — HKDI DESIS Lab is a cross-disciplinary social design research platform advocating "designers as enablers of social change" and social design. It is part of the international DESIS Network which comprises over 60 DESIS Labs around

the world and aims to advance international knowledge in design for the social good and to develop social practices that benefit Hong Kong society.

Media Lab

Media Lab is a forerunner of innovative media technology and its related applications. Through the experimentation with user experience design and convergent technologies, it aims to nurture and reinforce the integration of innovative ideas, media technologies and collaborations between education, applied research, professional training and industry applications.





HKDI GALLERY

HKDI Gallery is a dynamic exhibition arm of HKDI. Dedicated to present the exposition of cutting edge, top-notch international exhibitions and contemporary issues on design, HKDI Gallery also aims to support HKDI as one of the centres of design education in the region and promote design culture in Hong Kong.

HKDI Gallery engages with parties at home and abroad, including internationally acclaimed museums, designers and curators. With contemporary design as the cornerstone, it presents a series of top-notch exhibitions every year ranging from graphic design, architecture, fashion, product design, multimedia and so on.

Through international exhibitions, HKDI Gallery turns itself into an education venue where design students, design community and general public can learn from the masters' works. It also actively engages with institute's students and external students with tailor-made tours, talk and panel discussions.

World-Class Exhibitions

HKDI engages with parties at home and abroad, including internationally acclaimed museums, designers and curators. With contemporary design as the cornerstone, HKDI Gallery presents a series of top-notch exhibitions every year.

Dai Fujiwara “The Road of My Cyber Physical Hands” (2021)

This exhibition is a first-ever look into Dai Fujiwara’s earliest works tracing from his time as a student of design up to his most recent creations.

Look: The Graphic Language of Henry Steiner (2021)

Curated by the Department of Communication Design, the exhibition showcases the iconic works of Henry Steiner in the past 60 years and explores how they have represented the roots of brand image of Hong Kong’s prominent corporations.

Unseen - The Making of Traditional Chinese Furniture (2022)

Co-organised by HKDI Gallery and Hong Kong Palace Museum (HKPM), the exhibition reveals the aesthetics and value of traditional wooden craftsmanship behind the contemporary design furniture.

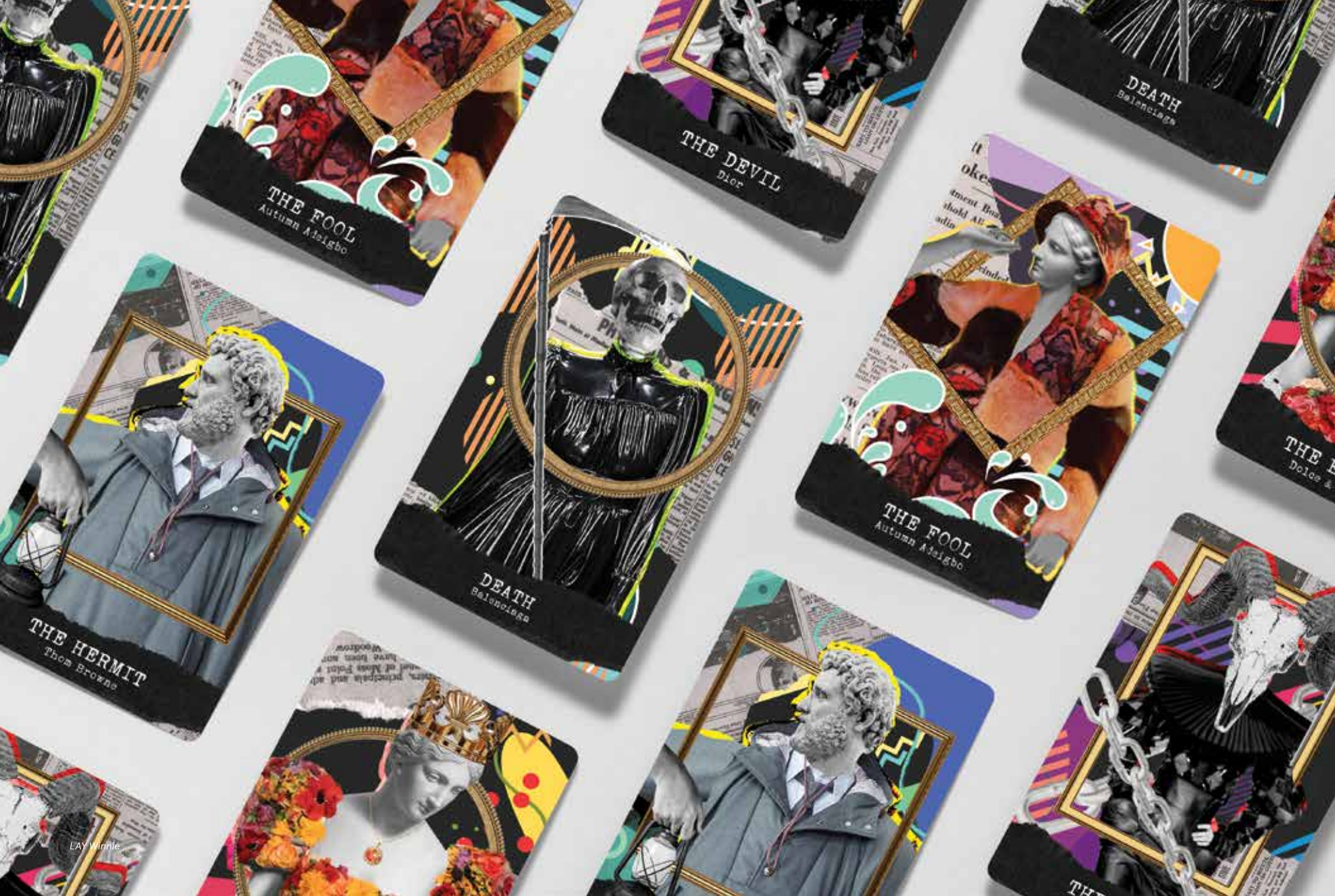

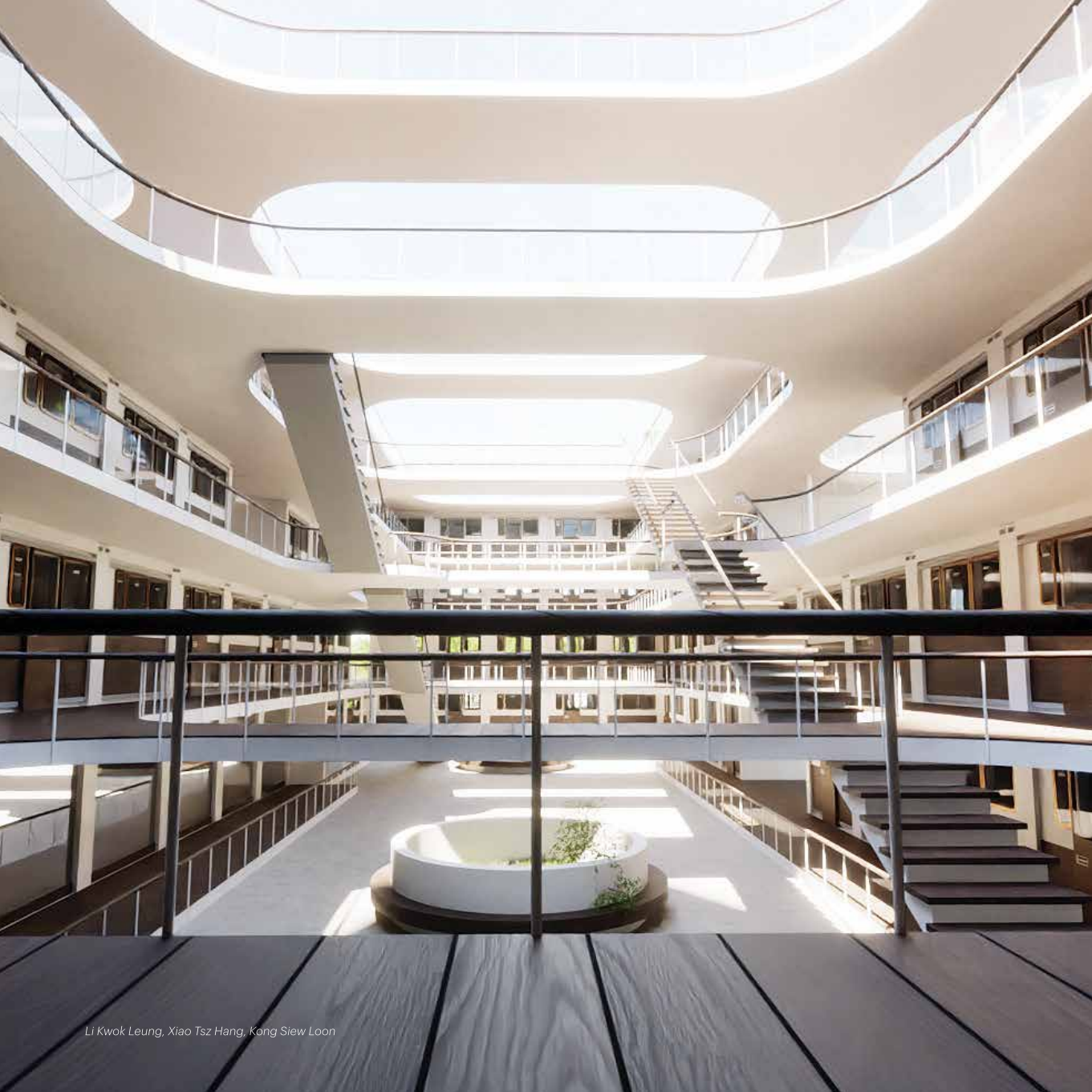

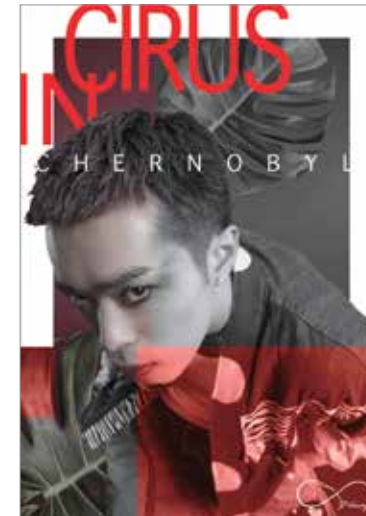

Professional Education and Engagement Centre (PEEC), the in-service training arm of Hong Kong Design Institute (HKDI), offers strategic lifelong learning opportunities, specialising in creative industries, for professionals and organisations across public and private sectors through award-bearing and non-award-bearing courses, workshops, corporate trainings, international executive programmes and seminars.
