Embracing the post-COVID era, the VTC moves with the times to meet the rising demand for skilled talents with an innovative and entrepreneurial spirit as well as a caring heart. We are delighted to see more and more graduates and students continuously applying their professional knowledge and new skills to contribute for the social good not just in Hong Kong, but also in the Mainland and beyond.
