 - Termination of 5A, 13A, 15A plugs and free socket
 - Connection of 13A plug and a terminal box

- 3 Basic Electrical Works
 - Electrical conduit cutting and bending for steel and PVC conduit
 - Steel conduit threading and assembling
 - Steel cable trucking and accessories assembling and installation

- 4 Electrical Installations
 - Practice in different type of commonly used wiring installations
 - Final circuits for lighting and power socket outlet installations using PVC and steel conduits

- 5 Mock Intermediate Trade Test
 - Practice in and review of electrical works similar to Intermediate Trade Test in Electrical Wireman
