I. JOB TITLE : GAS INSTALLER

II. JOB LEVEL : SKILLED WORKER

III. JOB DESCRIPTION : Installs, commissions, maintains and repairs domestic and non-domestic gas piping systems, gas appliances, gas utilization systems, and gas flow controls and meters connected to gas cylinders or gas supply points.

## IV. TRADE SKILLS : Ability to:

- 1. Correctly use and maintain the tools of the trade including power tools, test equipment and measuring instruments.
- 2. Install all types of commonly used gas piping and piping accessories.
- 3. Install all types of commonly used hot/cold water piping and its accessories to gas appliances.
- 4. Install gas appliances such as hotplates, water heaters and dryers.
- 5. Install gas utilization system components such as gas meters and governors/regulators.
- 6. Locate and repair faults in gas installations and equipment.
- 7. Read and interpret gas specification, piping diagrams and building plans.
- 8. Inspect, test, commission and maintain gas installation, supply system and equipment.
- 9. Use safety equipment, and protective devices and equipment.
- 10. Handle emergency of gas escape.
- 11. Correctly instruct, supervise and transfer skills to any apprentice and semi-skilled worker assigned to him to ensure safety and quality of work.

## V. TRADE THEORY : Knowledge of:

- 1. Engineering calculations associated with gas flow carrying capacity of pipes, meters, governors and related devices.
- 2. Piping diagrams and symbols.
- 3. Engineering calculations associated with combustion, flue and ventilation.
- 4. Properties of gas and its conversion.
- 5. Basic workshop practice, engineering materials and welding.
- 6. Basic electrical engineering and simple wiring diagrams.
- 7. Industrial hazards, safety and health precautions, and environmental concerns.
- 8. Installation practice and regulations, and relevant codes of practice.
- 9. Relevant ordinances and regulations.

#### VI. ENTRY ROUTE

: Preferred Minimum Entry Qualification:

Completion of Secondary 3.

### Training:

3-year organized apprenticeship or 2-year organized apprenticeship if preceded by a relevant one-year full-time basic craft course, with attendance at a relevant part-time day-release or block-release craft course in an institute of vocational education or equivalent.

# VII. STATUTORY REQUIREMENT

: A qualified gas installer should be a registered gas installer (RGI) of relevant classes under the Gas Safety Ordinance.
