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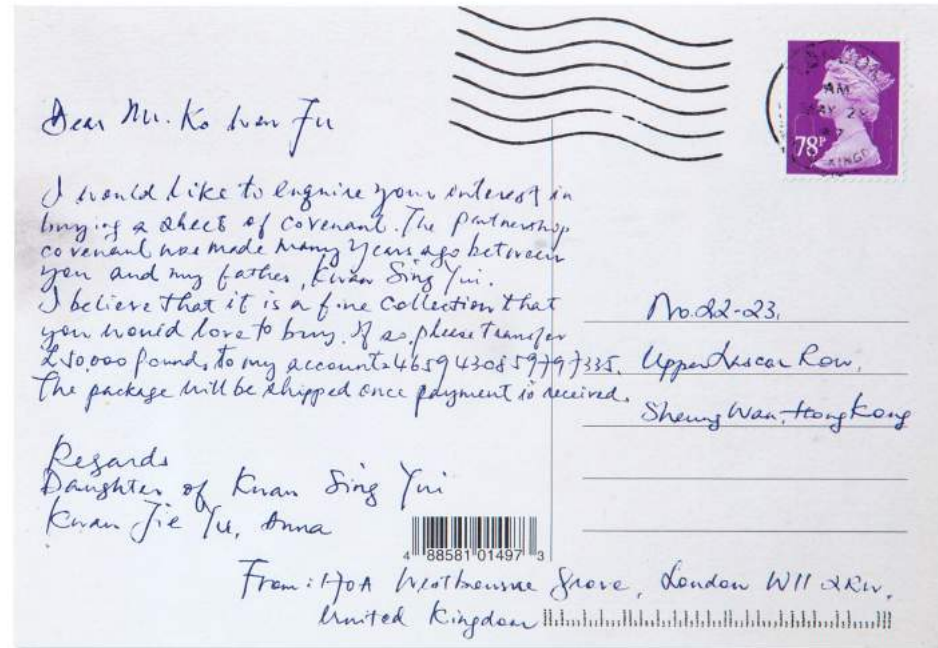

Kwan Antiques Shop in financial crisis may close down

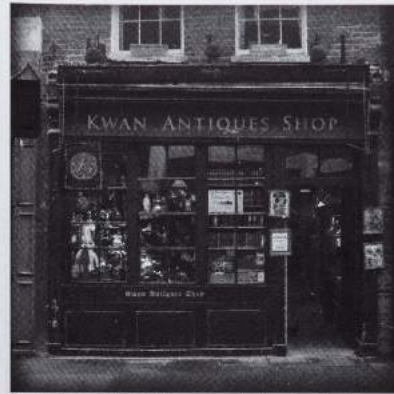
A business known for offering lost treasures will not be around for much longer. Anna Kwan, owner of Kwan Antiques Shop, claimed this month the business was not working, and possibly call it quit the first week of September, if no fundings are raised this month.

The 1,000-square-foot store is located at Notting Hill Gate, where it reopened in the mid 40s, briefly after the Second World War. During that time, Kwan Antiques was said to be operating at North London. It is one of the oldest antique shops that stood for over 50 years. The business was derived from Anna's father, which emigrated from Hong Kong after the Second World War. Kwan is believed to be the sole founder of the store and have been supporting alone for all these years; he died 5 years ago at the age of 77 due to critical heart failure. Since then the business is run by his daughter.

Kwan Antiques Shop sells antiques and second-hand goods, a lot of collections are from pre war, ranges from Roman jewels, cigars, manuscripts, foreign banknotes to Chinese Antique hand-made furniture. Many of the merchants are collection found by Kwan's father many years ago in Hong Kong.

The owner sat down in her store to discuss her time running the business. The shop was started because Anna's father was a great collector and loved collecting, "we got to the point where we needed somewhere to get rid of the stuff we had collected," she began.

"Unfortunately in the recent years, sales figure has been dropping for almost half each year. If no fundings are raised we will have to close down the shop," she continued, "Business just isn't what it used to be. It's slowed down a lot with the tourism," Kwan admitted. "The big thing for us was that I used to sell antique cigars," she noted. "I had a great big humidor and at this time, I

would have it full and I'd sold several times. The workmen could pull up with their trucks real easy, and I had a tripod sign outside that you could see for two blocks advertising," she recalled. "They would come in and not only buy something for their wives, or their wives would come in. But then that tobacco law came in and you couldn't advertise tobacco products anymore, so I had to take my sign down," Kwan said.

"That changed the traffic a lot." If the sales continue to drop, the next step of Kwan's will be to empty the store of all its collectibles, glassware, statues, and other antiques over its final few weeks. "Whatever's left over, we'll do yard sales and donating," Kwan noted.

And while their days running the business may be over, Anna will go back to her original hobby of book keeping.
