The Doctor had made sure that the letter should be there. It was produced and read.



"It is. I was kept for many months in the Abbaye prison without trial. I was set free only after Citizen Evrémonde had been imprisoned."



A business known for offering lost treasures will not be around for much longer. Anna Kwan, owner of Kwan Antiques Shop, claimed this month the business was not working, and possibly call it quit the first week of September, if no fundings are raised this month.

During that time, Kwan Antiques was said to be operating at North London. It is one of the oldest antique shops that stood for over 50 years. The business was derived from Anna's father, which emigrated from Hong Kong after the Second World War. Kwan is believed to be the sole founder of the store and have been
