Students can learn vocational skills at their own pace under the modular curricular structure. Apart from regular vocational skills training, there are also generic modules including Chinese, English, Practical Mathematics, Physical Education and Whole Person Development.

Whole person development/ Life planning education

The Centre is dedicated to the promotion of whole person development, assisting the students to understand more about their own personality, interests and strengths. Through life planning education, students are equipped with self-understanding skills and knowledge to make career orientation in accordance with their interests and abilities.





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Internship and training in the mode of social enterprises

The Centre collaborates with industries and community partners to offer a variety of skills training programmes to meet the market demands. Internship is an integral part of the training, which helps to strengthen students' vocational skills and confidence. Through internship, students will cultivate good working habits and positive working attitudes as well as understanding the genuine working environment and expectations of the employers. These could help to strengthen their adaptability to the working environment upon graduation.

Support Flow from 'Workshop Training' to 'Individual Care'

1. Pre-placement/employment time to help the students get a placement/ job and adapted to it

Counsellors work with the Class Teachers and Support Service Staff to look at the personal profile for students and identify industrial attachment/ employment opportunities. They will also provide pre-placement/ pre-employment counselling for job preparedness.

2. During the placement/ initial stage of employment

Counsellors continue to work with the Class Teachers and Support Service Staff to look at students' needs and help them solve the problems for setting in. They:

- visit the students at work to see if there are any issues that they need to resolve;
- contact the teachers in case the employments require trade skills that the students need further help from teachers;
- work out with the students' employers/ supervisors for co-assessing the student's performance during the training, and;
- help to resolve problems such as rearranging the workflow to facilitate the students' work or by counselling means to help the students' adjustments.

3. Post-employment support

The post-employment support helps graduates who need additional help. Issues related to trade elements will be referred back to the class teachers.

Professional support and counselling services

Through professional support services, we help students to build up their self-esteem and develop good interpersonal relationship. Multifarious extra-curricular activities are organised for the students to cater for their interests and enrich their campus life. Residential services with a total of 120 places are also available at Shine Skills Centre (Tuen Mun), providing a living environment where students can develop their social skills and self-care skills for independent living.

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Introduction

Shine Skills Centre (SSC) is a member of the VTC Group, offering skills training programmes for people with disabilities aged 15 and above to enhance their employment prospect. The three offering sites of Shine Skills Centre are SSC (Kwun Tong), SSC (Pokfulam) and SSC (Tuen Mun).

Shine Skills Centre provides specific and comprehensive vocational assessments and offers relevant training programme in full-time and part-time mode for people with special educational needs. In addition, the Centre provides technical aids, rehabilitation and residential services.

Users of Services

Shine Skills Centre provides vocational education and training, rehabilitation, skills training and professional support services to people aged 15 and above* who have special education needs (including attention deficit / hyperactivity disorder, autism, hearing impairment, intellectual disability, physical disability, mental illness, specific learning difficulties, speech impairment, visceral disability and visual impairment), and have basic self-care skills, to develop their employment potential and thereby to further their integration into society.



Applicants must be a permanent resident of Hong Kong or eligible to stay and work in Hong Kong without limitations by the Immigration Department.

Residential services with a total of 120 places are available at Shine Skills Centre (Tuen Mun), providing a living environment where students can develop their social skills and self-care skills for independent living.

School Bus

The school buses are equipped with wheelchair seating. Shine Skills Centre (Kwun Tong and Tuen Mun) provide point-to-point transport services for students who have difficulties in using public transport.

Application Period

Applications open every January for new students for the coming academic year.

Admission Procedures and Documents Required

- 1. Applications for the full-time programmes can be submitted by applicants of their own accord or referred by social workers, teachers or institutions.
- 2. Application forms can be downloaded from the Centre's website at www. shine.edu.hk. The form can also be obtained from the Secretariat of the Centres.
- Completed application forms and the relevant documents (e.g. medical, psychological, audiological or vocational assessment reports and case summary) should be returned to the Shine Skills Centre applied for;
- 4. Vocational assessment reports issued in the last three years would be considered.
- 5. With reference to the vocational assessment reports, suitable programmes will be arranged for enrolment.

Pre-enrolment Interview

Applicants should bring along the original copy of the following documents for the interview:

- 1. Hong Kong Permanent Resident Identity Card (Non-permanent resident should bring along their Hong Kong Identity Card, Visa or travelling document);
- 2. Relevant academic documents; and
- 3. A recent photograph of the applicant (photograph size: 38mm x 50mm) should be affixed onto the application form.





Senior Secondary Adapted ApL (ID) Courses

Senior Secondary Adapted Applied Learning (ApL) Courses for Students with Intellectual Disabilities are elective subjects in the senior secondary curriculum which complement other senior secondary subjects by offering studies with stronger elements of practical learning linked to broad professional and vocational fields. Students with intellectual disability in Secondary 5 and 6 can opt to take Adapted ApL Courses as their elective subjects.

Course Features

- 1. Adopt interactive teaching and provide practical training in a simulated learning environment
- 2. Focus on developing generic skills and nurturing students' vocational knowledge
- 3. Programmes tailored to individual's needs with traceable learning progress.
- 4. Adopt continuous and diversified performance assessment to evaluate students' learning performance

Admission and Fees

Students must apply through their school for enrolment in adapted ApL courses. Fees are subject to annual adjustment. (Fees are subsidised by the Education Bureau and respective schools. Students are not required to pay for the programme fees.)

Objective

120 boarding places are provided for full-time students with the aim to develop their self-care skills for independent living. Currently this residential service is available at Shine Skills Centre (Tuen Mun). Applicants interested in this may apply for studying at the Tuen Mun centre.

Dormitory Facilities

The Centre offers 12 dormitories, with a total of 120 places. Every dormitory is equipped with basic facilities, including a living room, a dining room, a kitchen, bathrooms and bedrooms.

Life Skills Training

The dormitory residence programme provides opportunities for students to build essential independent living skills under the guidance of the warden, such as grocery shopping, cooking, washing of dishes and clothes, tidying and cleaning up rooms.

Boarding Home Association and Interest Classes

Talks will be arranged in small groups for student residents, such as the use of money, time arrangement and social skills to enhance students' self-care skills for independent living. There are also interest classes such as discipline training, horticulture, Wing-Chun martial art, fragrances making, badminton and dancing.

Leisure Activities

Student residents are encouraged to read and take part in chess games or sports activities to make good use of their leisure time. Visits to community facilities, like shopping malls, libraries, city and community halls, sports centres, are also organised for them. They may participate in cultural and arts activities. Social gatherings, buffets and excursions will also be arranged to make dormitory life a colourful and memorable experience.

Fees

- 1. Dormitory Fees: to be paid by three instalments in August, December and April. In 2019/20, the fee of each instalment for students receiving Disability Allowance is HK\$3,420 and HK\$3,250 for those not receiving Disability Allowance. The fee for 2020/21 will be adjusted annually, and eligible students may apply for fee remission.
- 2. Air-conditioning charges: to be paid over two instalments in August and April at HK\$480 each (to be adjusted annually).
- 3. Meal charges: Dormitory fees cover meal expenses, including breakfast, lunch and dinner, with fruit supplies.
- 4. Activities fees: Transportation fees and partial activities expenses will be borne by the students themselves. (It is a licensed dormitory for persons with disabilities)





*Note:

1. All applicants who choose boarding service are required to go through a pre-admission interview and body check at their own expenses. If the applicants do not adapt the boarding life, withdrawal from boarding can be arranged.

Shine Vocational Assessment Services

Specific Vocational Assessment (3 days)

This customized assessment service caters for disabled persons aged 15 or above and:

Comprehensive Vocational Assessment Programme

(11 days)

People with disabilities aged 15 or above and not included under the aforementioned categories can apply for the Comprehensive Vocational Assessment Programme. This is a comprehensive assessment service adopting a multidisciplinary approach. The assessment team comprises a doctor, social workers, placement officers, occupational therapists and assessment evaluators. The assessment is conducted in small groups and on individual basis.

For students with special educational needs at Shine Skills Centre and other VTC institutions:

- 1. Providing technical aids, assessment and consultation on special education needs;
- 2. Providing technical aids, loan services for, e.g. wheelchairs, assistive walking aids, desktop video magnifiers, braille display.
- 3. Designing and adapting technical aids for individual to facilitate their study and work, e.g. adjustable desks in classrooms for wheelchair users, railings and ramps; or
- 4. Providing advice on exemption / special arrangements of examinations in the course of studies.

The Centre also offers consultation services and support to the people with disabilities who are seeking employment opportunities.


















