Entry Requirements

- Bachelor's degree with second class honours or equivalent; AND
- For non-native English speakers:
 - IELTS 6.5 (with no element below 6.0) or an equivalent recognised language test within the last 2 years; OR
 - At least 2 academic years of study in higher education within the last 2 years, which is taught and assessed in an English speaking country such as the UK, USA and Australia; OR
 - Employed and worked for at least the last 2 years in a company in which English is the corporate language as supported by a letter from the employer

Applicants with a post-experience diploma or higher diploma combined with appropriate working experience will be considered on individual merit.

Full-time: 1 year (Hong Kong / Overseas applicants)
Part-time: 2 - 3 years (Hong Kong applicants)
